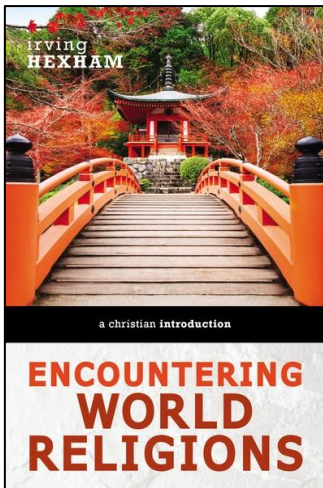


ENCOUNTERING WORLD RELIGIONS
